## William and Mary Looks to Avenge Loss Against Georgia State on Saturday

William and Mary will host first-year Colonial Athletic Association member Georgia State at Kaplan Arena on Saturday at 7:00 PM ... The Tribe lost its last game, falling at Northeastern, 84-69, on Thursday in the first-ever meeting between the two teams ... W&M is in 11th place in the CAA standings with a 1-10 conference record ... The Panthers will enter Saturday's contest on a two-game winning streak, including Thursday's 77-53 win at James Madison ... GSU is in ninth place in the CAA with a 3-9 league record.

## Storylines

Saturday's game will be just the second meeting between W&M and GSU ... The Panthers defeated the Tribe, 79-70, in Atlanta on Jan. 14 ... Sophomore guard **Nathan Mann** came off the bench to lead the Green and Gold with a season-high 21 points in that game, shooting 6-for-7 from the field and making five of his six three-point attempts ... Junior forward **Corey Cofield** had 12 points and eight rebounds, senior center **Brian Hutt** had nine points and a game-high 10 rebounds, while freshman guard **Calvin Baker** had 10 points, five rebounds, five assists and four steals in the game.

Despite junior forward **Corey Cofield** recording his 12th career double-double with 19 points and 11 rebounds in front of his hometown crowd, the Tribe lost at Northeastern, 84-69, on Thursday in W&M's most recent game ... Sophomore guard **Nathan Mann** had 13 points off the bench, while rookie guard **Calvin Baker** had 10 points, five assists, four rebounds and two steals in the game ... NU's 84 points was the most scored by a W&M opponent this season, and the Huskies shot 54.8 percent from the field in the game.

Freshman guard **Calvin Baker** was named the CAA Rookie of the Week for a league-high fourth time on Monday ... He also earned the honor on Nov. 21, Nov. 28 and Dec. 27 ... Baker leads W&M and is 13th in the CAA with 12.8 ppg ... He also leads the Tribe and is 12th in the league with 3.25 assists per game, while his 1.60 steals per game is second on the team and ninth in the CAA ... Junior forward **Corey Cofield** is second on the team with 10.3 ppg and has a team-high 5.3 rebounds per game ... Junior guard **Adam Payton**, a transfer from Vanderbilt, is third on the team with 8.1 ppg.

## Baker Named CAA Rookie of the Week for League-High Fourth Time

Freshman guard **Calvin Baker** was named the CAA's Rookie of the Week for the fourth time this season on Monday, Jan. 30 ... No other player in the league has earned the honor as often ... He also was selected for the award on Nov. 21, Nov. 28 and Dec. 27 ... He earned his most recent honor after scoring 15 points at George Mason (1/26) and 17 in a win over James Madison (1/28) ... Baker leads the Tribe and is 13th in the CAA in scoring with 12.8 ppg ... Baker also leads W&M and ranks in the top 15 in the CAA with 3.3 assists and 32.4 minutes per game ... He has scored in double figures 14 times this season, including eight games of more than 15 points ... Baker was voted to the W&M Tip-Off Classic all-tournament team to start the season ... At Woodside (Newport News, VA) High School, he was named the Virginia Group AAA Player of the Year by the Virginia HS Coaches Association and was picked as the state's co-player of the year by the Associated Press ... A two-time *Daily Press* Player of the Year, he led Woodside to state championships in 2004 and 2005 and was the MVP of the state's East-West All-Star game in July of 2005.

## Partners in Crime

Junior guard **Adam Payton** and rookie guard **Calvin Baker** are combining to average 3.40 steals per game, the second-best guard combination in that category in the CAA ... Payton ranks sixth in the league with 1.80 per game, just ahead of Baker who is ninth with 1.60 per game ... Those numbers currently rank the pair fourth and 11th, respectively, in a season at W&M since the steal officially became an NCAA statistic in the 1985-86 campaign.

## Hutt Doing the Dirty Work

Although scoring just 4.6 points per game, senior **Brian Hutt** has been a valuable force inside, second on the team with 4.7 rebounds and leading the team with 0.7 blocks per game ... Hutt has missed the Tribe's last four and played just four minutes at Virginia Commonwealth (1/19) due to a knee injury ... He has pulled down 10 or more rebounds three times this season and has led or tied for the team lead in rebounds six times ... Against Drexel (1/5), he recorded his first career double-double (and W&M's first of the season), with team highs of 12 points (on 6-7 shooting) and 10 rebounds in 28 minutes ... Hutt nearly had his second career double at Georgia State (1/14), with nine points and a game-high 10 rebounds (including nine offensive) ...

### He Set a Record in What?

When the new MTV show "Call 2 Greatness" visited the W&M campus this fall, senior **Hawley Smith** was selected from the crowd of students to attempt to set a world record in "pudding plonking," which involves hurling blood pudding from a frying pan ... According to MTV, Smith set an American record by launching the food to a distance of 117 feet, a mere 18 inches short of breaking the world record ... The episode is scheduled to be broadcast in April.

### Front Runners

In its six wins this season, the Tribe has had to play from behind for a total of just 14 minutes ... W&M led or was tied for the entire 40 minutes vs. Maine and Campbell ... ### Transferring Talent

**Smith** (Temple) and junior guard **Adam Payton** (Vanderbilt) ... Smith started nearly every game last season, but has seen limited action this year due to an ankle injury suffered a week before the season-opener ... Payton sat out last season, per NCAA transfer rules, but has started every game this year ... He scored a career-high 20 points 7-for-9 shooting at Virginia Tech (12/27) ... He also scored 19 points at Longwood (11/28) and had 18 points and seven rebounds in W&M's win at Hampton (11/22) ... The Tribe has had at least one transfer on its active roster every year but one since 1995-96 ... Each of the seven transfers since then were significant contributors with starting experience.

## W&M Signs Four Early

W&M head coach Tony Shaver and his staff completed their recruiting for next season's class with the signing of four individuals on the first day of the early signing period (Nov. 9). The four future Tribe players are 6-10 forward **Steven Hess**, 6-2 guard **Matt McFadden**, 6-3 guard **David Schneider** and 6-7 forward **Danny Sumner**.

### Steven Hess, 6-10, F, Gastonia, NC (Gaston Day School)

Hess averaged 16 points and nine rebounds for Gaston Day School last season, helping his team reach the semifinals of the state tournament in North Carolina's largest independent-school classification. He is a McDonald's All-American nominee and was an All-Southern Piedmont Athletic Association selection.

### Matt McFadden, 6-2, G, Medford, NJ (Shawnee High School)

McFadden averaged 13 points, five assists, four rebounds and 2.5 steals per game last season at Shawnee High School. A three-time team captain, he was an All-Olympic Conference selection last year, helping his team to a 25-2 record, as Shawnee HS won the South Jersey Group 4 championship and advanced to the semifinals of the state tournament.

### David Schneider, 6-3, G, Phoenix, AZ (Brophy Prep)

Schneider averaged 18.1 points, 6.2 rebounds and 6.1 assists per game last season at Brophy Prep and was a first team all-region and honorable mention all-state selection. His father, Jeff, played basketball at Virginia Tech, ending his college career in 1982 with 276 assists, ninth-most in school history, before being selected in the fifth round of the 1982 NBA Draft by the Houston Rockets.

### Danny Sumner, 6-7, F, Fairfax, VA (Paul VI)

Sumner averaged 14 points and 10 rebounds a game for Paul VI High School last season, as his team reached the Virginia Independent Schools Division I state final for the second straight year. Sumner was named to the 2005 Virginia Independent All-Tournament team and was an honorable mention Washington Post All-Metropolitan selection. He will be the Tribe's first men's basketball player from Paul VI since **David Cully**, who graduated from W&M in 1996 as the College's all-time blocked shots leader (248) and fifth-leading rebounder (783).

### New Schedule Format for CAA

With the addition of Georgia State and Northeastern to the CAA, the league will have an all-time high of 12 member institutions ... As a result, for the first time in conference history, the CAA will play an unbalanced schedule ... Each school has a set group of five opponents that it will play both at home and away each season ... The remaining six opponents are grouped into three pairs that rotate through the schedule every two years ... Each season a team will face two of those opponents both home and away, while playing the other four foes just once ... Using this rotation, each team in the CAA will host every league member at least four times in the six-year rotation ... W&M's annual home-and-home opponents are Drexel, James Madison, UNC Wilmington, Old Dominion and Virginia Commonwealth ... This season and next, the Tribe will also play two games against George Mason

and Georgia State ... This year, W&M will host single games against Delaware and Hofstra, while playing Northeastern and Towson on the road.

### Facility Upgrades

During the summer, W&M Hall underwent a major renovation project with the installation of a new hardwood floor ... The \$750,000 project included a wall-to-wall, 16,900 square foot permanent wood floor, large enough for two full basketball courts when the arena's bleachers are retracted ... The floor was manufactured by Connor Sports Flooring Corporation and was installed by Recreation Plus of Hopewell, Virginia.

### Back-to-Back Games

This is the third straight season and the fourth time in the last five years that the Tribe has opened the season with games on consecutive days ... Last season, W&M started the season by hosting the first Tip-Off Classic, winning both games ... Before that, the last time that the College opened the season with back-to-back home games was the 1956-57 campaign, when the Tribe defeated The Citadel (87-74) on Nov. 30 and Hampden-Sydney (98-81) on Dec. 1.

### Shaver Named to Episcopal HS Hall of Fame

Head coach **Tony Shaver** was inducted into the Episcopal High School (Alexandria, VA) Hall of Fame on Nov. 11 ... Shaver coached at the school for 10 seasons (1977-86), winning 73 percent of his games and two IAC championships ... After the 1986 season he was named the Virginia State Private School Coach of the Year and his team was ranked first in Northern Virginia by the *Alexandria Gazette*.

### Exhibition Game Recap

W&M defeated the University of Saskatchewan, 96-60, in an exhibition game between the two teams on Nov. 1 ... The game was tied at 10 with 13:10 to play in the first half, but W&M went on a 14-4 run and never looked back, leading 49-27 at the half and going up by as many as 40 points in the second half ... Five Tribe players scored in double figures, led by **Corey Cofield** with 16 and **Calvin Baker** with 15, along with a game-high seven assists ... Cofield and **Hawley Smith** tied for the team lead with eight rebounds ... Saskatchewan also lost at Old Dominion, 82-58, and at Virginia Tech, 90-42, as the

team played its first games against NCAA Division I opponents since 1965.



## Head Coach Tony Shaver

William and Mary head coach Tony Shaver is in his third season at the helm of the Tribe men's basketball program. Officially hired on May 2, 2003, Shaver is the 31st men's basketball coach in the history of the College.

"Bringing a coach and person the caliber of a Tony Shaver into the William and Mary program certainly makes this an exciting day for the College," said director of athletics Terry Driscoll at the time of the hire. "His resume speaks for itself in terms of his coaching abilities, but beyond that, I believe that he possesses all the intangible qualities that will make him a perfect fit for our school and program."

The Green and Gold continued to make strides in Shaver's second season leading the Tribe. W&M immediately started the season on a high note, defeating Radford and Hartford to win the inaugural W&M Tip-Off Classic, the first regular season tournament title for the College since 1981. The Tribe defeated James Madison in the first round of the Colonial Athletic Association Tournament for W&M's first postseason win since 1997, and just the third in the last 20 years.

Shaver began his Tribe career with a 91-64 pounding of Liberty on Nov. 23, 2003. He also won his first ever Colonial Athletic Association contest, as the Tribe knocked off two-time defending league champion UNC Wilmington, 67-66, in overtime on Dec. 4, 2003. In his first contest against a nationally ranked opponent, W&M also performed well, leading No. 15 Pittsburgh by 10 points midway through the first half, before the Panthers, who attempted 28 more free throws than the Tribe, won 70-55.

There have been individual successes as well for the Green and Gold under Shaver's reign. 2004 graduate Adam Hess, currently playing professionally in Europe, became the first player in school history to lead the CAA in scoring. An outstanding student and athlete, Hess was named the CAA Male Scholar-Athlete of the Year (for all sports) and was a first team Academic All-America and all-conference selection as a senior. Current junior Corey Cofield was voted the 2004 CAA Rookie of the Year, leading all freshmen in the league in points, rebounds and field goal percentage. Cofield earned his second straight selection to the All-CAA third team in 2005, while current sophomore Laimis Kisielius earned a spot on the CAA All-Rookie team last season.

Shaver came to W&M after coaching 17 seasons at Hampden-Sydney, compiling a record of 358-121 (.747). He turned the Tigers into a Division III national powerhouse, leading the men's basketball team to eight Old Dominion Athletic Conference titles, 12 20-win seasons and 11 NCAA Division III Tournament appearances. The winningest basketball coach in the program's history, he was named the ODAC and South Region Coach of the Year in 1995, 1999 and 2000, and was picked as the Virginia Sports Information Directors Division II-III Coach of the Year in 1997, 1999 and 2000.

In 2003, Shaver took the Tigers to the NCAA Division III Final Four, as his team finished with a record of 28-4, tied for the second-most wins in the program's history. In 1999, Shaver led H-SC to the national championship game, where the Ti-

gers lost by one point in double-overtime to Wisconsin-Platteville. The team finished 29-3, setting a school record for most wins in a season.

Shaver also has a firm commitment to his players' success in the classroom. In 1999, one of his charges, Jack Jirak, was named the ODAC Scholar-Athlete of the Year and was also awarded the Gammon Cup as the top-student-athlete at the college. Two of Shaver's players, David Hobbs (1999) and Russell Turner (1992) earned Academic All-America honors. A number of his players have been named to the Academic All-ODAC squad, including six student-athletes in 1998.

Shaver first led the Tigers to the national postseason in 1988-89, just his third season as the team's head coach. That year, H-SC won the ODAC championship, ending the season with a 21-8 record.

Prior to taking over at Hampden-Sydney for the 1986-87 campaign, Shaver spent 10 years as the head boys' basketball coach at Episcopal High School in Alexandria, Virginia. He was named the Virginia State Private School Coach of the Year in 1986, and was twice picked as the Alexandria Coach of the Year, while winning 73 percent of his games.

A 1976 graduate of North Carolina, Shaver was a guard on the Tar Heel men's basketball

team from 1972-75 under head coach Dean Smith. Originally a walk-on, he earned a scholarship his rookie season, when he was awarded the prestigious Butch Bennett Award, presented to the team's most outstanding freshman.

A native of High Point, North Carolina, Shaver and his wife, Ann, are the parents of three sons: Christopher (24), a former standout pitcher on the Tribe's baseball team, who is currently pitching with the Chicago Cubs organization, Austin (21) and Jackson (14).
