About the Tribe

William and Mary enters the Colonial Athletic Association Tournament with a record of 9-5-4 ... The Tribe finished tied with James Madison for fourth place in the league with a 4-3-2 conference record, good for 14 points in the standings ... Sophomore forward **Patrick Scherder** leads the team in scoring with 11 goals and 25 points, to go with his three assists ... Junior midfielder **Bryan Hinkle** has a team-best nine assists, is second on the team with 19 points and tied for second with five goals ... Seniors **Graham Albert** and **Phil Hucles** each also have five goals on the year ... Freshman goalkeeper **Kris Rake** has started every match this season and has a 1.38 goals against average with 61 saves and two shutouts.

In the CAA Tournament

This is W&M's 15th appearance in a CAA Tournament ... The Tribe has a record of 23-8-1 (.734) in the CAA Tournament, advancing to the semifinals 11 times, the final match nine times and winning the championship match five times (1983, 1995, 1996, 1999, 2000) ... W&M has won eight of its last 10 and 17 of its last 21 CAA Tournament matches ... The Tribe has lost in the CAA quarterfinals just once (1990 to Navy), but also failed to advance to the semifinals in 1993, after tying Old Dominion, 1-1, but losing in a penalty kick shootout ... W&M has won six CAA men's soccer titles (1983, 1987, 1995, 1996, 1999, 2000), more than any other school.

Winning Tradition Continues

With the Tribe's record currently at 9-5-4, the team has clinched its 29th consecutive winning season ... That is tied with SMU for the fourth-longest active streak in the nation ... The next closest active streaks are held by Duke (24) and Virginia (22), both of which are in jeopardy ... Both teams are one game under .500 this season, heading into the ACC Tournament ... W&M defeated Duke and Virginia on the road this season.

W&M Head Coach Al Albert

Head coach **Al Albert** became just the seventh coach in NCAA Division I history to record 400 career wins, when the Tribe defeated Delaware, 4-1, on October 24 ... In his 33 seasons at W&M, Albert has compiled a record of 401-186-64 ... He is one of just three coaches to have won as many as 400 games at the same Division I school, and has the fourth-most wins among active Division I coaches.

Senior **Graham Albert** and junior **Bryan Hinkle** both were voted to the College Sports Information Directors Association (CoSIDA) Academic All-District III sec-

ond team ... To be eligible for the award, student-athletes must be a starter or important reserve and have a cumulative grade point average of 3.20 or higher.

He's Back

Junior forward **Brannon Thomas** saw his first action of the season in Saturday's game against Old Dominion ... Thomas underwent brain surgery to remove a benign tumor in July and was not medically cleared to play until Friday ... He provided an obvious immediate spark to the Tribe offense when he came off the bench in the first half and ended up playing about 80 minutes in the double-overtime affair ... Thomas took two shots on goal and earned an assist, as he began the play which led to W&M's only goal of the contest.

Fit to be Tied

Four of the Tribe's games have ended in ties this season, as many as W&M had in the previous three seasons combined ... The school record for tied matches in a season is five, set in the 1982 season, when the team went 11-5-5 ... The Tribe has finished the year with four ties three other times (1988, 1989, 1992).

No Sophomore Slump

W&M sophomore forward **Patrick Scherder** has had an outstanding second season, leading the team with 11 goals and 25 points ... He has a team-high four game-winning goals this season and also has three assists.

Fewest Losses Since 1997

The Tribe's five regular season losses this year is the fewest for the team since 1997, when W&M was 13-4-2 entering the conference tournament ... This year the College hopes to end up better than it did that year, however, as the Green and Gold lost in the semifinals of the conference tournament and then fell in the first round of the NCAA Tournament, with both of those losses coming at the hands of American University.

ACC Dominance

W&M won all three of its matches against Atlantic Coast Conference opponents this season, defeating Duke (2-1), NC State (2-1) and Virginia (3-2, OT) ... The Tribe is the only team in the nation to post three non-conference wins against ACC schools in 2003 ... Along with wins over Duke and Virginia in last year's NCAA Tournament, W&M has won its last five matches against ACC opponents ... Even more impressive is that all of those matches were played on the opponent's home field, with the exception of the contest against NC State, which was played at Duke.

Tribe Looking for Fourth CAA Title This Fall ...

The W&M athletics department is having another of its typically outstanding fall seasons ... The Tribe has already won three of the four Colonial Athletic Association championships that have been decided this year ... W&M's men's cross country, women's cross country and women's soccer teams have all won conference titles ... The only holdout has been the Tribe's field hockey team, which earned a share of the regular season CAA Title, but did not win the conference tournament ... W&M has won 73 CAA Titles, 24 more than the next closest school, including an

amazing 45 of the 104 (43.3 percent) awarded by the CAA in its six fall sports (men's and women's cross country, men's and women's soccer, field hockey and volleyball).

... And the 130th League Title in School History

W&M's next league championship will be the 130th in school history ... The Tribe has won 73 CAA titles and won 48 Southern Conference championships from 1942 through 1977 ... In addition, W&M has won six ECAC gymnastics titles and two Atlantic 10 football championships.

Tournament Tidbits

W&M's fifth seed in the CAA Tournament is tied for its worst position ever in a conference men's soccer tournament ... The only other time the Tribe was the fifth seed in the CAA Tournament (1999) it responded by winning its fifth CAA Title ... James Madison is the only current CAA team that W&M has a losing record (3-4) against in CAA Tournament play ... The Dukies are also the only team that W&M has lost to more than once in the CAA Tournament.
