Friend Silas.

That letter and paper you ask me about. I picked up in the Mary and William Collage in Williamsburg the day after the Battle of that name, of course the town was well shaken. Genl Hookers brigade ours, stayed in ^{the} town one week, on account of the good service we done, there. The rebels used the Collage for there wounded they left behind. The Battle of Williamsburg was on the 5th of May 18.62.
