Tribe Women's Tennis to Compete at NCAA Individual Tournament

William and Mary women's tennis player **Megan Moulton-Levy** will open play at the 64-player NCAA Singles Tournament on Tuesday, May 23 at Stanford University's Taube Tennis Center ... She and Tribe rookie **Katarina Zoricic** are the first alternates to the 32-player doubles tournament and may also make it in to the event ... This is the second straight season that Moulton-Levy, a junior currently ranked 19th in the nation, has been selected to compete in the NCAA Individual Tournament ... In the singles competition last year, she lost in the first round to San Diego's Emma Murphy, 6-2, 7-5 ... Ironically, Moulton-Levy's most recent win in a national tournament also came against Murphy, a 7-5, 7-5 decision on Nov. 5, 2005 in the consolation draw of the ITA National Intercollegiate Indoor Championships ... Last season Moulton-Levy earned All-America honors in doubles, as she and **Candice Fuchs** reached the quarterfinals of the NCAA Doubles Tournament ... Should Moulton-Levy and Zoricic make it into the tournament this season, it would be the fifth straight year and the eighth time in the last nine seasons that W&M has had both a singles player and a doubles team compete in the NCAA Individual Tournament ... Singles play will begin on Tuesday, May 23, with the doubles tournament starting the following day ... Brackets and scheduling information for both tournaments will be released by the NCAA on Sunday, May 21.

About the Tribe

W&M ended this season with a 4-3 loss to NC State in the first round of the NCAA Tournament ... The Tribe is ranked 24th in the country and finished the year with a 16-9 record ... W&M played 16 matches against nationally ranked opponents, going 7-9 in those contests ... The Green and Gold went 3-6 against top-25 teams, including a win over No. 5 Duke.

Moulton-Levy Named CAA Co-Player of the Year

Junior **Megan Moulton-Levy** was named the Colonial Athletic Association's 2006 Co-Player of the Year, sharing the award with Virginia Commonwealth's Marianna Yuferova ... This is the second straight season that Moulton-Levy has received the award after earning it by herself last season—her first playing college tennis ... This is the 14th time that a W&M pplayer has been named CAA Player of the Year ... The NCAA also selected her as the CAA's automatic entry into the singles championship.

Katarina Zoricic Named CAA Co-Rookie of the Year

Tribe freshman **Katarina Zoricic** was named as this season's CAA Co-Rookie of the Year, sharing the honor with VCU's Tatsiana Uvarova ... Currently ranked 84th in the nation in singles and 33rd in doubles, Zoricic is third on the team with 25 singles wins and second with 22 doubles wins ... She is currently one doubles victory away from tying **Jessyca Arthur** (1998-99) and **Michelle O** (1994-95) for the ninth-most doubles wins by a freshman in W&M history ... A first team all-conference selection in singles and doubles, Zoricic has six singles wins and four doubles victories over nationally ranked opponents ... She is the sixth W&M player to earn CAA Rookie of the Year honors.

Moulton-Levy Takes Two ITA East Region Awards

Megan Moulton-Levy was selected as the recipient of a pair of ITA East Region honors this season ... The Tribe junior was named the region's "Player to Watch" and was also selected as the recipient of the region's Arthur Ashe Award for Leadership and Sportsman-

ship ... Last season she was named the ITA East Region's Rookie of the Year ... Moulton-Levy is just the second Tribe player to earn the Player to Watch honor, joining current senior **Megan Muth** who won the award in 2004 ... **Carolijn van Rossum** (2000) and **Jessyca Arthur** (2002) are the only other W&M players to be selected for the regional Arthur Ashe award, and both went on to win the national award as well ... This year's national ITA award winner will be announced on May 22.

Megan Muth Nominated for W&M's Senior Female Athlete of the Year

Megan Muth has been nominated, along with two others, for W&M's 2006 Senior Female Athlete of the Year Award ... The honor is handed out each year by the Tribe Club, which is the fundraising arm of the W&M athletics department ... Should Muth win the award, it would be the second straight season that a women's tennis player has earned the honor, after **Candice Fuchs** was selected for the award last season.

In the Rankings

Along with the team's national ranking of 24th, two Tribe singles players and one doubles team are also ranked ... In singles, junior **Megan Moulton-Levy** is 19th and freshman **Katarina Zoric** is 84th ... In doubles, Moulton-Levy and Zoricic are ranked 33rd.

Moulton-Levy Wins ITA East Region Singles Title

For the 13th time overall and the fourth time in the last four seasons, W&M claimed an ITA East Region individual title, when **Megan Moulton-Levy** won the region's singles championship on Oct. 27 ... The event was especially unusual, in that it pitted Moulton-Levy against her teammate, **Megan Muth**, who had won the title as a freshman in 2002 ... Moulton-Levy won all six of her regional tournament matches in straight sets, dropping a total of just 19 games (while winning 72) ... In addition to their regional singles championships, Muth won the ITA East Region's doubles title in 2003 (with **Amy Wei**), while Moulton-Levy took the region's doubles crown in 2004 (with **Candice Fuchs**).

Muth Fourth in Wins All-Time at W&M

One of the winningest players in W&M history, senior **Megan Muth** currently ranks fourth all-time at the College with her 214 combined singles and doubles wins ... Her 117 career singles victories is tied with **Johanna Sones** (1997) and **Carolijn van Rossum** (2000) for third place in the Tribe record book ... Muth also has 97 career doubles wins, placing her in sixth place in W&M history ... A seven-time first team All-CAA selection, Muth was named the CAA Rookie of the Year in 2003 and the CAA Co-Player of the Year in 2004, when she

earned All-America honors in doubles ... A two-time ITA East Region champion (singles in 2002 and doubles in 2003), she advanced to the region's singles championship this season, before falling to teammate **Megan Moulton-Levy**.

W&M in the NCAA Singles Tournament

Entering this season, W&M has had 18 players make 27 appearances in the NCAA Singles Tournament ... In addition to **Megan Moulton-Levy's** appearance last season, current senior **Megan Muth** competed in the event in 2004, reaching the second round ... The Tribe has had at least one player reach the second round in seven of the last 11 seasons, although no W&M player has gone farther than that in that time frame ... The only time a Tribe player has won at least two matches was, coincidentally, at Stanford's Taube Tennis Center in 1992 ... That year **Julie Shiflet** won three matches, before falling in the quarterfinals to Laxmi Poruri (Stanford) and **Karen van der Merwe** won two matches before losing to Heather Willens (Stanford) in the round of 16 ... With a 3-1 (.750) record at the tournament, Shiflet is the only Tribe player with a winning record at the event, although five players (including Muth) have a .500 record at the singles championship ... Entering this season, W&M players have combined for a 15-27 (.357) record at the tournament.

W&M in the NCAA Doubles Tournament

W&M has had 16 doubles teams, made up of 22 individuals, make a total of 17 appearances at the NCAA Doubles Tournament ... Should the Tribe duo of **Megan Moulton-Levy** and

Katarina Zoricic, currently the first alternates to the tournament, make the event, this will be the fifth straight season and the 17th time in the last 20 years that the Green and Gold has had at least one doubles team participate in the tournament ... Last season, the doubles team of Moulton-Levy and **Candice Fuchs** earned All-America status after advancing to the quarterfinal round ... It marked the second straight season that a Tribe doubles team advanced to the quarterfinals, as **Megan Muth** and **Amy Wei** also won two matches at the event in 2004 ... The only other time that that a Tribe duo has performed better at the event was in 1998, when **Lauren Nikolaus** and **Michelle O** advanced to the semifinals ... W&M's doubles teams have combined for a 16-17 (.485) record at the tournament.

2004-05- Sophomore

All-American in doubles, as she and Candice Fuchs reached the quarterfinals of the NCAA Tournament ... CAA Player of the Year ... ITA East Region Rookie of the Year ... First team All-CAA in singles and doubles (with Fuchs) ... Also competed in the NCAA Singles Tournament ... Won ITA East Region Doubles title with Fuchs ... Ended the season ranked 40th in the nation in singles ... Finished 17th in the nation and first in the east region in doubles with Fuchs ... Voted the most outstanding performer of the CAA Tournament ... Won all three of her No. 1 singles matches at the event in straight sets, losing just five games all tournament ... Named CAA Singles Player of the Week on March 16 and picked with Fuchs as the CAA Doubles Team of the Week on March 16, April 5 and April 12 ... Ended the dual-match season by winning nine of her last 10 singles matches ... Defeated seven nationally ranked singles players in the spring, including straight-set wins over No. 29 Elena Gantcheva (UNLV), No. 52 Helena Besovic (TCU), No. 60 Marianna Yuferova (Virginia Commonwealth) and No. 75 Courtney Vernon (South Florida) ... Went 25-11 in doubles with Fuchs, including seven wins over ranked opponents ... The pair were ranked as high as 16th in the nation during the season ... They defeated three top 25 opponents in the last two months of the season, with wins over No. 15 Dianne Hollands/Maja Mlakar (Arizona), No. 16 Olga

Borisova/Yuferova (VCU) and No. 25 Katie Ruckert/Kendra Strohm (Texas) ... They won their first two NCAA Tournament matches in straight sets, before falling to the nation's second-ranked team in the quarterfinals ... Recorded a 12-4 singles record in the fall, defeating four ranked opponents ... Upset No. 19 Jackie Carleton (Duke), 6-3, 6-1, in the first match of her college career on Sept. 24 at the W&M Invitational ... Lost to teammate Megan Muth, ranked 15th in the nation, in a three-set semifinal match, before defeating Diana Srebrovic (Virginia) to finish third at the tournament ... Advanced to the semifinals of the regional singles championship, before losing to No. 27 Courtney Bergman (Harvard) ... Won eight straight doubles matches in the fall with Fuchs, winning the top flight of the Hampton Roads Invitational, along with the East Region championship.
