Dear Sir

Richmond 17th June 1790

I am favoured with your letter of the 16th current by your Brother, & beg Ten Thousand Thanks for having given you the trouble of writing it - I alone can't blame, nor ought to have we collected the settlement which had taken place here of your account with J. & B. - But in the hurry of business it really had escaped my memory, in order to satisfy your Brother that this was the case, I turned up my Ledger to him, & showed him your account balanced thereon, The Messrs in London are not blameable for sending you a copy of your account with them, because they did not know of the settlement which had taken place here

I trust you will have the goodness to forgive this blunder, & be assured that if you render you any service in London, it will give me much pleasure
